### **Tasmania's Draft Climate Change Action Plan 2023-2025**

I refer to our previous correspondence in November and December 2021 regarding the *Climate Change (State Action) Amendment Bill 2021*.

I note that the Government now invites comments on the Draft Climate Change Action Plan 2023-25 (Draft Plan) and I write in support of the submission provided by the Cement Industry Federation (CIF) in relation to the Draft Plan.

As you are aware, with over 100 years of local history, Cement Australia produces over 25 per cent of Australia's domestically produced cement in Australia at its integrated manufacturing facility in Railton, Tasmania.

Cement Australia notes that sector-based Emissions Reduction and Resilience Plans (ERRPs) will be developed shortly in partnership with industry.

It is critical that both Cement Australia and the CIF receive direct and early engagement on the development of the following ERRPs:

- Energy and transport;
- Industrial processes and product use (IPPU); and
- Waste

I would appreciate your advice on the next key consultation dates in relation to the above.

I look forward to working together with the Tasmanian Government to ensure the ERRPs developed are practical and achievable as noted in your letter dated 10 December 2021.
