An amended climate act should: Set sector targets with timeframes for all sectors, which reduce over time consistent with NZE targets. We need this so that we can genuinely reduce emissions across the board and not just rely on "windfall" or "offset" reductions from the LULUCF sector Talk clearly about fossil fuels, with time-based commitments to reducing fossil fuel production and use across all sectors in the Tasmanian jurisdiction Establish a bona-fide independent body to monitor and advise on the Tasmanian "energy transition", or whatever you want to call it Establish a just and fair phase-out of all burning of wood to waste by 2030 (proper bushfire management/fuel reduction burns excepted) and all burning of wood for space heating, electricity generation and industrial heat by 2050.
